Event: Walk on The WILD-flower-SIDE with Deborah Sillman, Biologist

On Saturday, Deborah Sillman, Penn State New Kensington Assistant Teaching Professor in Biology and editor of the website *Flowering Plants of Harrison Hills Park*, will have a presentation at 10AM to noon on the wildflowers she has found in Harrison Hills Park to date.

The presentation will be followed by a stroll searching for some of the approximately 150 wildflowers that she has found, identified and photographed in the park and posted on her website, located at sites.psu.edu/harrisonhills.

Her website showcases the diversity of flowering plants that can be found in the 500 acre Allegheny County Park Harrison Hills, including those most people would never notice on a walk in the park. She reminds us that small or showy, flowers enrich our world and remind us that all life should be respected and celebrated.
